


24-Month Accelerated Bachelor's in Nursing Program



Pursue a **new career in nursing** in just 24 months



Designed for college graduates who are interested in pursuing a new career in nursing, this program features the same curriculum as the 12-Month Accelerated Bachelor's program, but at a modified pace and in a **fully-online format**.

The 24-Month Accelerated Bachelor's program option allows students to **balance** work and other commitments while earning a fully-accredited second bachelor's degree with a major in nursing from the University of Rochester.

Students in the 24-Month Accelerated Bachelor's program will complete:

- 1-3 courses each semester over six consecutive semesters
- 49 credits of online coursework, including a combination of synchronous and asynchronous classes
- **90 lab/skills hours**, including a combination of online activities, onsite lab intensives, and in-person simulation experiences
- 650+ clinical hours across nursing specialties at the University of Rochester Medical Center, ensuring you receive essential hands-on experience

Upon completion of the program, students will be prepared to sit for the **NCLEX-RN exam** to obtain RN licensure.

Eligibility Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in a field other than nursing from an accredited school
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 from the most recent relevant degree
- Completion of prerequisite course requirements before starting the program
- English language proficiency

- Current resume or CV
- TOEFL, IELTS, or DET scores for international applicants who are non-native English speakers
