Purpose of Grant:

The Sigma Theta Tau Epsilon Xi Research Grant recognizes a nurse who has proposed a research project of high quality that demonstrates that nurse's future promise as a nurse scientist.

Grant Amount:

Up to \$1500 and certificate

Grant Criteria:

- Scholarly project with importance/relevance to nursing
- Future potential contribution to scholarship/theory/knowledge
- Preference is given to new nurse researchers without other sources of funding

Eligibility:

- Registered Nurse who has completed or is currently matriculated in a PhD/EdD program
- Formal training/previous experience with planning/conducting a scholarly project (or under direct supervision of a qualified professor)
- Active Epsilon Xi Chapter Membership

<u>Application Requirements:</u>

- Epsilon Xi Grant Application
- Executive summary of project (15 single-spaced typed pages addressing: background/significance, purpose/aims/goals, methods, analysis, evaluation, references, appendices)
- Detailed budget with justification for expenditure (not to exceed \$1500)
- Letter of support from advisor/chairperson (for student projects) or colleague who is knowledgeable about this project (for non-student projects)

Grant to be presented on November 11, 2019 at the Annual Fall Event/Induction Ceremony
