Similar duties and responsibilities as below but focus shifted to responsibility for overseeing the Nurse Practitioner programs as we progress toward a revised post-baccalaureate to DNP nurse practitioner program, without a Master's exit. Duties for overall MS program are shared among three co-directors (two for NP programs, one for the Leadership and MNE programs). There are currently ~375 MS students, as of Fall 2020, enrolled in these programs; 227 in the NP programs alone.

**Director, Master of Science (MS) Programs** (11/2012-6/2020)

Reporting to the Dean of the school, at the University of Rochester School of Nursing, this position has overall curricular responsibility for six NP specialties (adult-gerontology acute care, adult-gerontology primary care, family, family PMH, pediatrics, and neonatal), the Leadership in Healthcare Systems program (which includes two leadership concentrations; Healthcare Organization Management and Leadership and Clinical Nurse Leader), as well as our Master of Science in Nursing Education program (NYSED

approved in 2015). There are ~180 students enrolled in these programs and the faculty numbers 18 individuals at full-time status and many more with part time commitments. The Program Directors (Undergraduate, Master's, Doctoral, and Center for Lifelong Learning) work with the Associate Deans and appropriate faculty committees to address: curricular issues; course and program evaluation; student recruitment, admission, and progression; and student advisement. In collaboration with faculty committees, they have primary responsibility for the integrity of the programs, including coordinating the sequencing across programs for curriculum, courses, student flow, and clinical sites. In addition, they work with the Associate Deans on program budget issues and faculty assignments. The Program Directors work with the Associate Deans in recruitment of faculty and provide input on faculty performance. In addition, they advise the Associate Deans about future needs for the program clinical sites.

In this role, the Program Director oversees the Annual Master's Program Preceptor Recognition and Workshop Day each spring. This program is provided to all MS program preceptors and awards contact hours to attendees. The budget for the program [~\$10K] is provided by the SON as a benefit to the preceptors. I have served as the coordinator for the 18<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> annual programs (2013-2019). We will begin the planning process for the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual program in Fall, 2019. Spring 2020 program was canceled by COVID-19 Pandemic.

#### Associate Director, Master's Nurse Practitioner Programs (2011-2012)

Reporting to the director of the Master's programs, this position had responsibility for overseeing the development and ongoing offering of our NP and post-Master's certificate NP programs: Adult and Adult/ Gerontology NP, Acute Care NP, Care of Children and Families (PNP), Family NP, and Family Psychiatric Mental Health NP. Serving as a mentor to new faculty, problem solving about student issues, and discussing pedagogical concerns with faculty were a significant component of this position.

#### Specialty Director, Adult-Gerontology Primary Care Nurse Practitioner Program (2014-present)

This program became the **Adult-Gerontology Primary Care NP (AGPCNP)** program on July 23, 2014, following NYSED approval. Activities are the same as those described in the following entry. We also have a post-Master's certificate program approved by NYS for this new specialty, based on the National Consensus Model guidelines.
